What is a Feature Pack?



A "Feature Pack" delivers features, in addition to fixes. Our intent is to provide Feature Packs at a cadence of 3-4 per year.

 Notes / Domino 9.0.1 will be the baseline release and future updates will be delivered as feature packs on top of 9.0.1.
 This provides a mechanism for continuous delivery and eases deployments.



Notes/Domino Feature Packs

- Our objective is to accelerate the delivery of more features into the N/D platform, hence changing approach to gather components into <u>quarterly featured packs</u> for a <u>continuous "agile" delivery model</u>.
- "Core" technical elements required to support the longevity of Domino applications are initially targets for feature pack shipments ...
- Allow us to speak about <u>continued enhancements</u> and have a simple nomenclature <u>without costly Version.Release naming</u>
- <u>Template updates</u> will continue to be separate but aligned with the next closest Feature Pack release.
- <u>Sametime</u> on-premises switching to same Feature Pack model!
- Remember also: As of Sep 6, 2016, any downloads (Fixes, Feature Packs, etc.) are only available to customers with active S&S or Dual Entitlement subscriptions!




What is iDNA?



- iDNA is a **virtual appliance**, which collects various infrastructure information and collates it into meaningful data for use by IT departments and management. These environment reports allow you to see which applications are being actively used, which servers are barely used or not used at all, what end-user usage patterns are like, when load peaks occur, and much more.
- Analysis results are possible for but not limited to virtually any question pertaining to IBM Notes client traffic, IBM Domino servers and application usage.

 While iDNA Foundation already provides significant value on its own, it is also the perfect starting point for a wide range of custom tailored iDNA Analytics engagements.





Domino Environment Overview






